


# **ANDE WEST AFRICA**

The Investment Manager Training (IMT) is ANDE's flagship professional development course for investment professionals deploying capital to Small and Growing Businesses (SGBs) in emerging markets.

The five-day, in-person course delivers hands-on training in sourcing deals, conducting due diligence, structuring investments, managing portfolios, and planning exits - supported by real-world case studies and peer learning.

Since its inception, the IMT has trained hundreds of investment practitioners globally, equipping them to make impact-driven, commercially sound investments that catalyze entrepreneurship and sustainable growth.

In February 2026, ANDE West Africa will host the next edition in Accra, Ghana, themed "Climate Innovations in Agri-business & Food"; convening 25–30 early- to mid-career investment professionals from across the region.


